by Yuval Noah Harari.

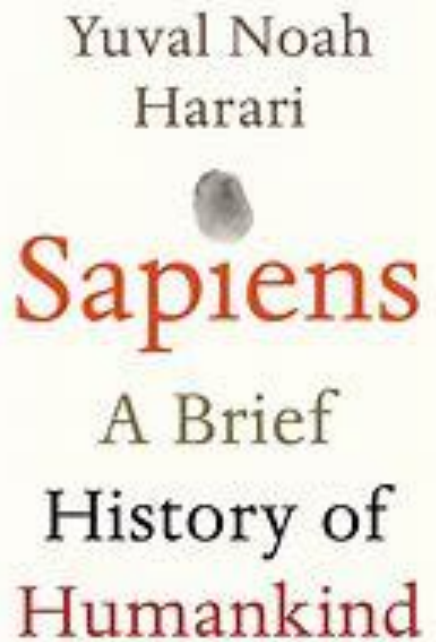
About the Book

Sapiens is an interdisciplinary book that surveys the history of humankind through evolution and reviews themes of biology, history, sociology and economics to tell a story of our history.

The first book in a series of two (Homo Deus follows) it starts 'from this provocative idea...Sapiens goes on to retell the history of our species from a completely fresh perspective. It explains that money is the most pluralistic system of mutual trust ever devised; that capitalism is the most successful religion ever invented' (www.ynharari.com). Harari looks at our culture and society today and asks provocative questions such as 'is modern agriculture the worst crime in history?'

His ideas are broad and vibrant, and although the book is dense at times and you may need to be motivated to read it quickly, the subject matter is incredibly interesting and vivid.

With over 10 million copies sold it seems to be a popular choice. We would recommend it to anyone interested in evolution and how society forms. A solid Christmas present idea!
